



CONSTRUCTION MAINTENANCE WORKER TRAINEE

Under the general supervision of the Field Operations Supervisor, the employee will perform semi-skilled maintenance and construction activities associated with the installation and repair of water, natural gas, or wastewater lines. Other duties may involve maintenance to water and wastewater plants, pump stations, wastewater lift stations, and various natural gas stations. The employee may operate medium-weight equipment with supervision and perform carpentry, masonry, and other miscellaneous tasks related to provision of water, natural gas, and wastewater services. The employee is expected to fulfill rotational assignments and to remain on-call according to rotational schedules.

All candidates must possess a valid State of Alabama driver's license and a driving record that would allow insurability by the Board's insurance. All candidates MUST be a graduate from senior high school or equivalent.
